- New Business
 - ❖ Feedback regarding Jasmine has increased this semester.
 - Students enjoy the new additions, such as kimbap.
 - Students expressed concerns about prices, the portion sizes and the variety of rice.
 - Students expressed concerns that some menu items in Nutrislice do not include the ingredients of the dish.
 - Students don't like that some food trucks don't accept dining dollars.
 - Students want more halal options, however, there is halal food at Jasmine. Additional advertising about halal options is needed.

- Students want the utensil dispensers back.
- A student feels that the service can be a little intimidating when asking for extra food at the Chinese station in the afternoon.
- The meat in hibachi is chewy. If the meat sits on the grill too long, the meat can get chewy.
- Students feel that the containers are smaller with less rice and little protein, however, the portion sizes have not been changed. The portion sizes are reviewed by Laura Martorano, MS, RD, CDN, Campus Dietitian. The protein is 4oz.
- If the chicken sits still longer than ten minutes, the chicken gets soggy.
- Students would like to see more authentic Indian food. The chicken masala is too soggy.
- Students like grab-and-go options and the chicken teriyaki bowl.
- Students prefer Asian markets outside Stony Brook than the one on campus.
- Mixed reviews about Jasmine.
- Some students have created a connection with the workers at Jasmine which brings attraction to the place.
- The sizes of the containers change the perception of how much food students are getting.
- ❖ There is less feedback coming from Jasmine compared to East Side Dining.
- ❖ Additional Student Feedback:
 - Students wonder if there could be a hot shoot at Jasmine.
 - More assorted fruits in cups.
 - Include Jasmine in the meal exchange plan. SBU Eats is aware, but it takes time and strategy.
 - Students asked where the foldable tables were. They were replaced with new seating.
- ❖ There are plans to improve the front and back of Jasmine.
- ❖ The kitchen is aware of the portion issues and they are working on it and are open to receiving suggestions.
