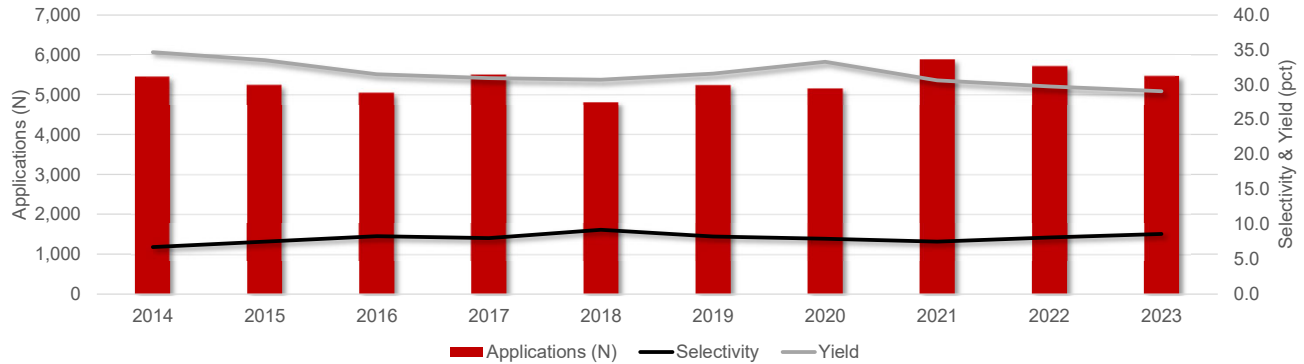

This section tested examinees' ability to develop a central idea, synthesize concepts and ideas, present ideas cohesively and logically, and write clearly following accepted writing conventions. Applicants who took the old MCAT exam prior to January 2013 will have MCAT results for this fourth section, reported on an alphabetic scale that ranges from J (low) to T (high)."
