- **A member** of a Native American Tribe.

If selected for a sponsorship, applicants must provide proof of residency upon registration into the program.

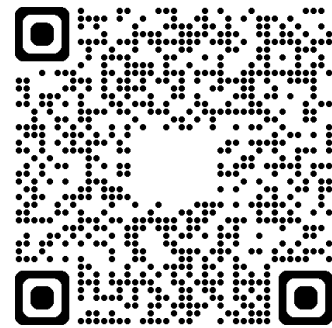
